The world's oldest picture garden. Established in 1916. Come and relive the history of Sun Pictures. Sun Pictures is perhaps the only picture theatre in the world to have been subjected to continual tidal flooding. Its unique location is under the flight path to the runway at Broome airport. Films through the decades have been interrupted at strategic moments by the engine roar and flashing lights of a landing

aircraft, often accompanied by applause from generations of movie lovers.

Anastasia's Pool & Gantheaume Point



A small pool in the rocks located at the end of Gantheaume Point Road. A former lighthouse keeper built the pool for his wife to soak her arthritic bones and exercise her limbs. Situated against the turquoise blue waters and contrasting Pindan Rocks it is a photographer's dream.

Broome has an incredible history, impacted substantially through the Pearling Industry, WWII and our Indigenous population. The Broome Museum is well worth a visit.

STAIRCASE TO THE MOON





The breathtaking natural phenomenon known as Staircase to the Moon is caused by the rising of the full moon reflecting off the exposed mudflats at extremely low tide - creating a beautiful optical illusion of stairs reaching to the moon. Staircase to the Moon is a natural attraction and its visibility varies in strength depending on weather, sunset, moonrise and the tide. The Staircase to the Moon in Broome is often complemented by the local markets at Town Beach. Here you can sample local fare, purchase crafts and delight in talented local entertainers.
