Champagne Chamberlain Gorge Cruise

Exploring the Chamberlain Gorge is a lovely afternoon. Only accessible by boat, this 3km fresh waterhole is bound by diverse flora and fauna and belittled by a towering escarpment. Enjoy sparkling wine and fresh fruit as you take in the breathtaking scenery. Ask your Ranger about the cheeky Archerfish and Barramundi you can feed.

Bungle Bungle & Ragged Ranges Flight (ELQC)

Explore the Bungle Bungle Range from above on this 2-hour scenic flight from El Questro. Take in stunning views of the East Kimberley landscape including the Ragged Ranges, Lissadell and Texas Down Stations and the Osmond Range before the iconic bee-hived striped domes of the Bungle Bungle Range come into sight. On the way back track towards El Questro flying over the decommissioned Argyle Diamond Mine, home to 95% of the world's pink diamonds.

Punamii Unpuu Walking Trail Mitchell Falls

Fly | 4WD | Hike | Day Tour | Heli

This adventure packed day showcases the Punamii-unpuu Hiking Trail, spectacular ancient rock paintings, and the iconic Mitchell Falls.

Departing El Questro we track along the Pentecost River and onwards to the Mitchell Plateau for an 8am landing. We have morning tea at the international lounge then drive down an eyecatching bush track surrounded by ancient Livingstonia palms, to the Mertens campground (Ranger Base) and the start of the 4.5km Punamii-unpuu Hiking Trail. Along the way swim, explore and enjoy trail snacks at the Little Mertens Falls. Be inspired and humbled by the mysterious, ancient rock art found beneath the falls, featuring the mythical Gwion Gwion spirit figures. Next stop is the awesome Big Mertens Falls and the upstream crossing of the Mitchell River before arriving at the spectacular Punamii-unpuu (Mitchell Falls). Here you have time to enjoy your lunch, relax and swim. We then take an exhilarating helicopter ride over the Falls back to base where we drive back to the airfield for a well-earned cold beer, wine or a cup of tea, before the homeward flight, via the Cambridge Gulf, Wyndham and a low swoop over the Lower Ord wetlands.

Day 8 on your tour is a 'free' day where Adventure Wild offer guests the opportunity to explore Kununurra, relax and do as you please. The following options are available to you.

Triple J Ord River Cruises

An enjoyable way to spend the afternoon exploring Kununurra, Lake Argyle, Durack Homestead and Ord River is with the award winning Triple J Tours. The 55km journey down the Ord is the longest continuous daily river cruise in Australia.

Tour J3 - Ord River Discoverer with Sunset

Your tour begins with a coach trip through Durack country to Lake Argyle (70 km) and includes visiting the historic Durack Homestead Museum. This museum was constructed as a replica of the original family home and uses the original stone.

After a short drive, we view enormous Lake Argyle. Crossing the Ord top dam wall guests will see the Ord Hydro-Power Station before boarding their Triple J Tours boat for a scenic 55 km cruise back to Kununurra. Marvel at the spectacular scenery, wildlife, flora and fauna found along the way, maybe even spot a crocodile.

Enjoy afternoon tea at the riverside camp before heading back to Kununurra. Take in a colourful East Kimberley sunset before docking at the marina & our transfers to return you to your accommodation.

Helicopter Flight Bungle Bungles


A helicopter flight is a must when you are in the Purnululu National Park and this exhilarating flight allows you to take a close up view of the gorges you will walk through. See spectacular areas not accessible by ground. View the Western Wall and incredible sights including; Cathedral Gorge, Piccaninny Gorge & Creek, Deep Gorge, Y Gorge, the beehive domes and much, much more.

Pricing and scenery viewed will vary depending upon flight duration and flight departure location. Flight times can vary from 18 minutes to 60 minutes. Helicopter flights are usually taken from within Purnululu National Park at Bellburn Airstrip.

A30	The sandstone massif of the Bungle Bungle Range is almost 99 times the area of Uluru – there are more stunning features and spectacular landforms to see in this half hour scenic flight than you would imagine possible. View the hidden red rock gorges of the north-west tip, Piccaninny Gorge from end to end and the unique beehive formations that have contributed to the listing of Purnululu National Park as one of Australia's World Heritage areas.	\$499	
The Ultimate Bungle Bungle Flight			
A42	 A42 A42 Depart Bellburn Airstrip for the southern tip of the Bungle Bungle Range to view Deep Gorge and 'The Twins'. Continue on to the highest point of the Bungle Bungle and the spectacular red rock gorges of the north-west. View the eastern side of the range to encounter incredible eroded sandstone formations and a maze of gorges, soaring over the Valley of the Giants with its massive sandstone structures. Fly along the southern face to the mouth of Piccaninny Gorge, follow Piccaninny Creek to view Cathedral Gorge and the famous orange and black striped beehive shaped domes.
